- Charges include ferry/shuttle fee, green fee, shared buggy, one free basket of driving range balls, prizes and dinner. Transportation to / from the ferry pier shall be arranged by the players at their own expenses.
- Competition:** 18-hole Individual Stableford on Allowed Handicap
Men: **White** tees Ladies: **Red** tees
Maximum Handicaps allowed : Men 22 Ladies 28
- Detailed competition rules will be issued to the participants separately
- Guests** The HKIEGS Chairman Cup trophies are for HKIE members only. Guests are welcome to play (only eligible for nearest to pin and longest drive prizes). There are 40 places on first-come-first-served basis. HKIEGS members are given priority.
- Winner Point System & Prize Collection** In appreciation to members' support, a Winner Point System was established in Session 2008/2009. Points would be allocated to prize winners (including Gross Champion, Net Winner, 1st Runner Up, 2nd Runner Up, Best Front Nine, Best Back Nine, Closest to Pin or Longest Drive) of each HKIEGS golfing activity. All HKIEGS members who have participated these golfing activities are eligible to accumulate the points. Members who have accumulated certain points in each session are entitled to a prize according to the below categories:
- Category A – Members who have gained above 600 points would receive 3 boxes of golf balls
Category B – Members who have gained between 300 to 600 points would receive 2 boxes of golf balls
Category C – Members who have gained below 300 points would receive 1 box of golf balls
- All points would be accumulated up to two years and shall be forfeited automatically after. Prizes will be presented to members who have accumulated more than 100 points in Session 2008/2009 during the AGM on that day. Detail arrangement on the prize collection will be sent to members by email.
- Insurance:** It is entirely the participants' responsibility to take out insurance to cover their
