Programme Overview

NEC3 is a suite of standard contracts which provides a legal framework as well as project management procedures that can be used on a wide range of construction and engineering projects. The main characteristics of NEC3 are flexibility, simplicity and clarity, and stimulus to good project management. The NEC3 is regarded as being suitable for partnering arrangement due to the operation of its core clause which refers to acting “in the spirit of mutual trust and cooperation”. This seminar will introduce the common philosophies of the NEC3 suite of contracts and focus in more details upon the key provisions of the NEC3 Engineering and Construction Contract (ECC). The speaker will also touch on some frequently asked questions concerning the application of NEC3.

About the Speaker:

Dr Christopher To is currently the Executive Director of the Construction Industry Council, Hong Kong, and was previously the Secretary General of the Hong Kong International Arbitration Centre. He is an accredited mediator, chartered arbitrator, chartered engineer and chartered information technology professional.

Dr To holds adjunct professorships from a variety of academic institutions and is on the board of a wide range of organisations ranging from education, engineering and IT to research and development. He is the immediate Past Chairman of the East Asia Branch of the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators, an At-Large Council Member of the Inter-Pacific Bar Association, an Executive Committee Member of the Hong Kong Corporate Counsel Association, a Council Member of the Hong Kong International Arbitration Centre and the Asian Domain Name Dispute Resolution Centre.

Dr To has written substantially on the subjects of Alternative Dispute Resolution, International Construction Law, International Arbitration, Commercial Contracts and Mediation. He is a sought-after speaker/moderator at international forums and he lectures regularly at various leading universities. In 2001, Dr To was the youngest director awarded the Director of the Year Award in Hong Kong and in 2007 he was named as a Young Global Leader by the World Economic Forum.
