Energy consumption in buildings is the major contributor to greenhouse gas emissions in Hong Kong. Incorporation of a variety of energy saving technologies in building's installation works can optimise venue utility and improve energy efficiency of the building for an achievement of direct energy saving.

Apart from the hardware enhancement for building services and systems, awareness and daily practice among the building users are also important as our consumption behaviour directly affects our environmental performance. In this topic, the speaker will demonstrate and share Hong Kong Baptist University's holistic energy conservation strategies on both the application of advanced technology and the engagement of stakeholders for the University's commitment to the sustainable development.
