His research interests include Automation in Construction, Sensing Technologies, and Construction Simulation.

Monitoring construction activities at sites is essential as successful projects are often determined by the level of awareness of project status or work performance. However, it is one of the most variable and time-consuming tasks for most stakeholders (e.g., owners, contractors, architects, engineers, suppliers, etc.), and yet continues to be mostly a manual task. Hence, a growing need exists to leverage the advancements in automated technologies for better monitoring and control of construction projects. This seminar will introduce state-of-the-art technologies and methodologies for automated monitoring of construction activities, and review their potential and limitations to identify future direction.
