Modular Integrated Construction (MiC) is gathering momentum in Hong Kong. The InnoCell is the first MiC project for a permanent development securing approval from the Buildings Department.

The 17-storey InnoCell sits on a 32,000-sq ft site adjacent to the southeast entrance of Hong Kong Science Park. The construction of the InnoCell will apply the MiC technology enabling off-site manufacturing in a prefabrication factory and then transportation to site for installation. MiC has been proven effective to enhance building productivity and safety, construction quality and sustainability, supported by success cases in the US, the UK and other countries.

In this technical visit, members would have the opportunities to visit the completed InnoCell Hostel and be introduced with the design and construction of this pioneer MiC project in Hong Kong.
