Technical Seminar: Electrical Installation in Public Housing

《The talk will be delivered in Cantonese》

The Hong Kong Housing Authority (HKHA) formulates and implements public housing programme aiming to meet the housing needs of low-income families that cannot afford private accommodation. HKHA plans and builds different types of public housing, including rental housing, interim housing, transit centres and subsidised sales flats. They also manage and maintain all of them except for subsidised sales flats. Electrical systems play an important role in enhancing the living standard of the tenants. In this seminar, Ir Yu will share with us the historical development of electrical installation and the latest electrical system design in public housing estates.

Ir YU Pui Yuk, Patrick received his BSc(Eng) in Electrical Engineering and MSc(Eng) in Building Services from the University of Hong Kong. He started his fruitful career in both the public and private sectors with EMSD, Ove Arup & Partners and Airport Authority for 12 years. After that he joined the HKHA in 1998. He is currently the Chief Building Services Engineer. In his 20-year service life in HKHA, Ir Yu had worked in both the Estate Management Division and Development and Construction Division which covers all aspects of electrical engineering works of Public Housing Estates from development to operation and maintenance. Outside work, he is also active in various engineering societies, such as the Green Building Council and CIE(Hong Kong).
