Major Changes of the Code of Practice (CoP) for the Electricity (Wiring) Regulations 2020 Edition and Introduction of EV-charging at Home Subsidy Scheme

Module 1 : Major Changes of CoP for the Electricity (Wiring) Regulations 2020 Edition (to be presented by Ir Johnson Sze, from EMSD)

The new Code of Practice (CoP) for the Electricity (Wiring) Regulations 2020 Edition has been published to the industry at the end of 2020 and will be fully implemented on 31 December 2021 after 1 year of grace period. Major changes of the latest CoP as compared between 2015 and 2020 Editions will be highlighted in this webinar.

Module 2 : Introduction of EV-charging at Home Subsidy Scheme (to be presented by Ir MK Lam, from CLP Power Hong Kong Limited)

To promote low-carbon driving to make Hong Kong a greener and smarter city and support the Government's newly launched EV-charging at Home Subsidy Scheme, the local power company is launching an advanced dedicated service which will provide one-stop technical support and customer service to Green Motorists interested and qualified in applying for funding for electric vehicle (EV) charging-enabled infrastructure in the car parks of private residential blocks.

Ir Johnson Sze is the Electrical and Mechanical Engineer of the Electricity Legislation Division of EMSD of HKSARG. The Electricity Legislation Division of EMSD is the regulatory authority responsible for the enforcement of Electricity Ordinance and its subsidiary legislations, as well as publication of relevant Code of Practices, Guidance Notes and Technical Guidelines, with the mission of enhancing electricity safety in the community.

Ir MK Lam, the Senior Planning & Design Manager of East & West Region of CLP Power Hong Kong Limited is responsible for implementation of CLP Power Eco Charge 2.0 in support of Government's EV-charging at Home Subsidy Scheme in particular in the supply capacity preliminary assessment and provision of technical support on supply arrangement to the additional EV chargers requested by the scheme participants.
