Programme Highlights

Hong Kong West Kowloon Station, equipped with fifteen tracks, is a multi-level underground station with a footprint of over 10 hectares and floor area of 400,000 square meters, and is the largest underground train station in the world. It is conveniently located next to the West Kowloon Cultural District and serves as the southern gateway of Guangzhou-Shenzhen-Hong Kong Express Rail Link (XRL) as well as the national 22,000 km long high-speed passenger rail network.

The station was formally opened on 4 September 2018 and high speed trains started to run to destinations in Mainland China from 23 September 2018.
