Jury’s Citation of Winning Projects (abstracted from GBA 2023 ebooklet)	Enhancement Works for Kwun Tong Sewage Pumping Station Grand Award (NEW BUILDINGS CATEGORY: Completed Projects – Institutional) 

The project transforms an environmentally malignant infrastructural construction into a “playful” green deck park to benefit local neighbourhoods in Kwun Tong. Adopting natural lighting inside the pumping station by incorporating big skylights not only saves electricity consumption but also creates an appealing architectural design for the park. The landscape and ecology design effectively adopts around 60 plant species to promote biodiversity. On the deck, there are over 60 “playful” playground and educational facilities, including those that fulfil the needs of different ages and physical abilities. The building has fulfilled its mission of promoting the importance of sewage treatment, water conservation, and sustainability.

This project stands as a true testament to the possibilities of sustainable design and construction, pushing the boundaries of environmental responsibility, resource efficiency, social engagement and occupant wellbeing.
