- Venue: Kau Sai Chau Public Golf Course – East Course
- Date: Thursday, 9 November 2023
- Fee for 18-holes competition: **HK\$1,050 for HKIEGS Members (Green fee for 18-holes + HKIEGS Polo Shirt)
HK\$1,500 for HKIE member who is not a member of the HKIEGS or guest
(HK\$140 discount for members or guests at an age of 60 or more)**
- Charges include green fee, locker, one complimentary basket of driving range balls, golf carts, ferry, dinner and competition prizes. Other expenses will be at the player's own expenses.
- Fee for golf experience session: **HK\$200 for HKIE Members
(1-hour golf clinic by professional trainer + 1-hour practice)**
- Time: Tee-off time is from 12:00noon
- Starter Tee : Men: White tee Ladies: Red tee
- Competition: New New Peoria (新新貝利亞)
Prizes include
i) Gross Score Champion
ii) Net Score Champion, 1st Runner-up and 2nd Runner-up
iii) 4 Individual Nearest to Pin at Par 3 holes (Hole 3, 5, 13 and 15)
iv) 1 Individual Longest Drive at Par 5 hole (Hole 10)
- Competition Rules: The prizes of (i), (ii) and (iv) of the Competition are for HKIEGS members only. Guests and first time joining new member are welcome to play in the event but are only eligible for nearest to pin prizes (iii). In general, each HKIEGS member can only get one prize except for prizes (iii) and (iv).
- In the best interest of time, gimmie is allowed if distance is less than the rod length of a standard putter. Play ready golf, i.e. whoever is ready, hit first!
- Always keep up with the group in front. If your group cannot keep up with the group in front, the flight leader (player highlighted at the flight schedule) should control the speed of play by all possible means such as by only allowing one practice stroke, stopping players to continue after 3/4/5 over for a particular hole (i.e. double par), forcing ready golf etc. If your group is too slow and forced by the Club Marshall to skip a hole, the whole group would have the score of double par for that hole.
- If a ball is lost in water or other hazard (yellow or red stakes), the player may, under the penalty of one stroke, drop a ball near the margin of the hazard. However there must be reasonable evidence that the ball lodged in the hazard. If available, Drop Zone must be used. For ball lost and out of bound, use drop zone or drop the ball at the point of entry with a penalty of **ONE** stroke.

For rules not mentioned in the above, follow the Local Course Rules. For rules not mentioned in the Local Course Rules, follow R & A Rules.

If there is any doubt, the HKIEGS Committee's decision will be final.

Score: Flight leader will be responsible for marking the scores for the flight. Please enter the gross number of strokes for each hole, i.e. 5, 6, 7 etc., not +1, +2, and "Double Par" is the maximum for each hole. Marker and Players should sign the card and hand it to the person in charge of scores immediately after the round.

Dinner: Kau Sai Chau Golf Course Restaurant. Dinner at around 6:30pm.

Dinner Activities President's Speech, Sponsor's Words and Prize Presentation will be arranged during the Dinner.

Insurance: It is entirely the participants' responsibility to take out insurance to cover their participation in the golf competition. HKIEGS assumes no financial, legal or any responsibility for any type of claim whatsoever arising from their participation.

Weather: Unless typhoon signal no. 8 or the black rainstorm warning is hoisted by 6:00a.m., please assume that the event will proceed. Final decision will be made from the Golf Course Organization.

Registration: For registration, please complete and return the registration form (registration form can be downloaded at the HKIE website: <http://www.hkie.org.hk/golfsociety>) to the Conference & Function Section of the HKIE together with the appropriate payment on or before **16 October 2023**. Each participant should fill in a separate registration form. Payment should be made by cheques payable to "HKIE - Golf Society". The HKIEGS reserves the right to release and cancel the booking if the appropriate payment is not received on time.

The acceptance to your registration is considered on the first-come-first-served basis. The HKIEGS members are given priority. Members will be admitted to the waiting list of the event if registration is full and will be informed if further places are available. **To promote friendship among the participants, request for grouping more than two participants in the same flight might not be entertained. Please note that acceptance/rejection of the request is subject to the discretion of event manager.**
