# Report from Divisions and Other Committees 2010/2011

## July 2010

**Building Services Division:** The Division co-organised the “Liaoning – Hong Kong Joint Symposium” in Dalian with the Hong Kong Chapter of the American Society of Heating, Refrigerating and Air-Conditioning Engineers (ASHRAE), Hong Kong Branch of the Chartered Institution of Building Services Engineers (CIBSE) and the Department of Building Services Engineering of The Hong Kong Polytechnic University. This is an annual event held in Hong Kong and different mainland cities to provide a platform for better communication between engineering professionals in Hong Kong and the Mainland China.

## September 2010

**Biomedical Division:** A three-week “Biomedical Engineering Roadshow 2010” was organised by the Division with the opening ceremony held at Jinan University in Guangzhou on 13 September. The roadshow, exhibiting more than 50 panels from universities and engineering enterprises in Hong Kong and Guangdong, helped promote biomedical engineering excellence.

**Building Division and Civil Division:** Both Divisions visited a number of major pavilions at the “Shanghai Expo 2010”.

**Civil Division and Environmental Division:** The two Divisions jointly organised the “Fifth Symposium on Sustainable Development” from 27 to 30 September with the Guangdong Provincial Association for Science & Technology and the Macau Institution of Engineers. Themed “Creating Quality Living in the Pearl River Delta Region”, the symposium featured prominent speakers, technical presentations and site visits to Hong Kong, Macau and Guangzhou. With a view to enhance living quality in the Pearl River Delta, the event provided a valuable forum for trade professionals to share knowledge on the latest policies and project experiences.

**Fire Division:** The Division organised a local technical visit to the old Tai O Police Station on Lantau Island, during which presentations on structural safety, fire safety and conservation were shared.

## October 2010

**Building Services Division:** As a community service, volunteers from the Division carried out electrical safety inspections for about 100 elderly homes in the Western District on Hong Kong Island.

**Control, Automation & Instrumentation Division and Environmental Division:** The two Divisions participated in “The Second China-ASEAN Forum” at Guangxi. The event provided a forum for scientific and technological exchanges and helped foster co-operation amongst professional bodies in Guangxi, Hong Kong, Macau and members of the Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN).

**Electrical Division:** The theme of the 28th Annual Symposium of the Division was “Modern Projects – Challenges and Solutions”. In addition to the keynote speech delivered by Ir Prof C C Chan, a total of 10 papers were presented. The symposium was well received by over 300 participants.

**Gas & Energy Division and Mechanical, Marine, Naval Architecture & Chemical Division:** A four-day technical visit to Qingdao and Weihai in Shandong Province was jointly organised by the two Divisions. The visit enabled the delegates to understand the latest technological development in various industries covering home appliances, wind power, and auto parts manufacturing on the Mainland.

**Information Technology Division:** The Division organised a series of three interactive seminars aiming at creating a forum for senior IT professionals to share their experiences with young engineers and potential engineers. The seminars also offered the audience the opportunity to discuss face-to-face with the speakers including Ir Dr the Hon Samson Tam, JP, Legislative Council Member, and three IT specialists from different industries.

**Young Members Committee (YMC):** The YMC launched a mentorship scheme with the Boys’ & Girls’ Clubs Association of Hong Kong (BGCA). Selected young engineers were paired up with young students to provide a one-on-one mentorship service. To strengthen bonding and facilitate mentoring, a series of workshops was organised for the pairs by the YMC and BGCA. As a result, our young members gained a better insight into the needs of teenagers, especially those who are underprivileged.

## November 2010

**Biomedical Division:** One of the major events of the Division was the “BME2010 Biomedical Engineering International Conference and Pre-Conference Workshop, Hong Kong”. Since 1992, the biennial BME Conference has been a meeting point for biomedical professionals of different nationalities and disciplines. “BME2010 Hong Kong” comprising a two-day scientific presentation/workshop, a one-day pre-conference workshop plus a one-day technical visit, served as a platform for biomedical engineers, researchers, regulators, industrialists and healthcare professionals to exchange information on the latest developments and achievements in the field. Dr York Chow, JP, Secretary for Food and Health of the HKSAR Government, was the Guest of Honour at the conference.

**Civil Division:** The Division organised the “Guangdong, Hong Kong, Macau and Taiwan (GHMT) Engineers Forum” in Xiamen. The forum, under the theme “Green Construction & Eco-city Development”, provided an opportunity for delegates from the four locations to share and exchange their green engineering experience, knowledge and culture.

**Electrical Division:** The Division and CLP Power Hong Kong Ltd jointly organised the “Energy Innovation Project Competition” for upper secondary school students. Students were required to work in teams to build projects to promote energy efficiency with innovative ideas. The competition attracted a total of 58 entries.

## December 2010

**Civil Division:** 33 young engineers and advisors joined the six-day “Winter Camp with China Civil Engineering Society – High Speed Rail” in China. The programme included visits to Wuhan, Beijing and Tianjin on the high-speed trains (at a maximum speed of 330km/hour) of the Wuhan-Guangzhou Line.

**Electronics Division:** The Division organised two technical visits: one to the Hong Kong Applied Science and Technology Research Institute (ASTRI) and its Material & Packaging Technologies Group and the second one to the Hong Kong Science & Technology Parks (HKSTP) and its Material Analysis Laboratory. The former visit helped Division members learn a great deal about how ASTRI delivers world-class leading-edge technologies and customer-focused research and development service catering for the needs of the industry. The latter visit enabled members to understand how HKSTP provides laboratory facilities, engineering support, consultancy service and professional training to worldwide customers.

**Nuclear Division:** More than 300 members participated in the “Forum on Low Carbon Energy and Climate Change” organised by the Energy Advisory Committee of the Environment Bureau of the HKSAR Government. Ir Dr B L Luk, Chairman of the Division, was invited to present a talk entitled “Is Nuclear Energy Safe and Reliable?” to enable discussion on what future energy mix in Hong Kong could help combat climate change.

## January 2011

**Manufacturing & Industrial Division:** The “Aircraft Engineer Development Scheme (AEDS) Annual Dinner” was successfully held on 15 January and was well attended by more than 100 students and guests. The AEDS was organised by the Division and supported by the Hong Kong Aircraft Engineering Co Ltd and the Royal Aeronautical Society (Hong Kong Branch). At the dinner, Mr Jeffrey Ying, the first Chinese who successfully flew a single-engine aircraft around the world, delivered a talk on his adventure in aviation.

**Safety Specialist Committee (SSC):** The “Annual Dinner and Award Presentation for the HKIE SSC Student Project Competition 2010” was successfully held on 21 January with about 150 participants. The main objective of the event was to provide a learning and communication platform for engineers, experts and relevant parties to share knowledge and experience in safety and health management.

## February 2011

**Fire Division:** More than 400 members and guests attended the Division’s Annual Dinner on 24 February. Ir Lee Shing See, JP, Chairman of the Construction Industry Council, was the Guest of Honour of the dinner.

## March 2011

**Building Division:** The Division organised the 10th Annual Seminar entitled “Eco-City Construction – Restructuring, Redevelopment and Revitalisation”. The seminar was a forum for sharing of expertise and experience in design and construction of green and sustainable buildings in Hong Kong. It covered a wide range of topics including energy efficiency, building design, construction techniques, town planning and rehabilitation. It also looked into recent works, trends and techniques, and broadly examined the planning and development of environmentally friendly buildings in Hong Kong.

**Building Services Division:** The Division arranged a technical visit to the Pat Heung Depot of the Mass Transit Railway Corporation (MTRC). As part of the Division’s voluntary work, this visit was arranged for the youngsters of Hong Kong Federation of Youth Group.

**Electrical Division:** The Division organised for its members an array of professional short courses covering various aspects of electrical engineering. Due to the overwhelming level of interest, a total of seven classes were offered in March and April instead of the four classes originally planned.

**Environmental Division:** The Division organised an Annual Seminar entitled “Green Transport for Low Carbon City” on 5 March. A total of 13 distinguished speakers from local and overseas were invited to share their knowledge, views and experience on green transport. Mr Edward Yau, JP, Secretary for the Environment of the HKSAR Government, was one of the local speakers at the seminar.

**Gas & Energy Division:** The Division and the Institution of Gas Engineers & Managers – Far East District Section jointly organised a symposium and technical visit to the China Gas Association in Hangzhou, China on 25 and 26 March. Energy experts from different countries gathered at the symposium to discuss the principles, applications, strategic meanings and market analysis of distributed energy system. All participants were impressed by the high efficiency of the distributed energy system on the Mainland and gained a better understanding of the current situation of distributed energy system in China.

**Geotechnical Division:** The Division’s Annual Dinner was well attended by about 330 participants. The AECOM Prizes for Best Student Awards, Best Final Year Geotechnical Project Awards and Fugro Prizes were presented at the dinner. Ir T C Chew, Projects Director of MTRC, was invited to deliver a speech.

**Materials Division:** About 320 participants attended the “Winter Workshop on Green Building Materials 2011”. This one-day workshop addressed the key developments in eco construction materials and the sustainable construction environment. Leading scholars and professionals shared their experiences in working with materials for green concrete, green construction and eco building systems for engineering a greener community.

**Mechanical, Marine, Naval Architecture & Chemical Division:** The Division organised a delegation to Singapore and visited a number of local icons such as NEWater Visitor Centre, Chemical Processing Technology Centre, Land Transport Gallery and Marina Barrage.

**Nuclear Division:** Following the earthquake in Japan on 11 March and the subsequent nuclear crisis at Fukushima, the Division organised a technical seminar on “Fukushima Daiichi Nuclear Power Plant & Loss-of-Coolant Accident” on 25 March. The speakers shared their views on the accident and also discussed the safety issues relevant to the nuclear power stations at Daya Bay. About 120 participants attended the seminar.

**Structural Division:** The Division organised the “Structural Excellence Award 2011” with an aim to promote excellence in structural engineering adopted in the design and construction of buildings and structures.

**Safety Specialist Committee (SSC):** A one-day symposium on “Safety in Construction” was jointly organised by the SSC and the Department of Real Estate & Construction of The University of Hong Kong on 4 March. Prominent speakers from the construction industry were invited to share the latest information and measures in enhancing safety in construction. About 120 participants attended the symposium.

**Young Members Committee (YMC):** The Committee organised the “YMC Overseas Delegation 2011” to the United Kingdom. Under the theme “Engineering London for and beyond 2012”, three major areas namely infrastructure development, urban planning, and Olympic facilities were studied during the visit. In addition, as an effort to enrich the knowledge of the delegates, a series of ten local visits/seminars were arranged.

## April 2011

**Civil Division and Materials Division:** The two Divisions jointly organised a Professional Services Development Assistance Scheme (PSDAS) Seminar on “Concrete Production in Hong Kong – Past, Present and Future: Some Reminiscences”. The seminar recalled the history and evolution of the concrete industry in Hong Kong. The speakers also offered insights from an insider perspective into the current trend and future challenges of the concrete industry for achieving economical and sustainable construction. About 180 participants attended the seminar.

**Control, Automation & Instrumentation Division:** The Division arranged a delegation to visit the China Association for Science & Technology, and the China Instrument & Control Society in Beijing on 3 - 5 April. Ir Dr Louis Lock, Chairman of the Division, shared the green power concept and the successful application of 5S philosophy at Lamma Power Station in Hong Kong.

**Electronics Division:** The Division jointly organised with the Department of Electronic Engineering of The Chinese University of Hong Kong and the Hong Kong Trade Development Council the “Symposium on Lighting – New Materials and Technologies”. In the symposium, recent developments in LED technologies were discussed by local and overseas experts and scholars.

**Fire Division:** The Division’s third Annual Symposium themed “Global Emerging Trend in Fire Engineering Design” was held on 6 April. Prominent speakers from the fire engineering industry were invited to share the latest global trends and information on fire engineering practices adopted in Hong Kong and worldwide for enhancing fire safety. Nine papers were presented by local and overseas fire experts and specialists, discussing how state-of-the-art technologies and fire engineering designs could increase the level of safety in buildings, and providing innovative ideas on possible solutions. Mr Ambrose Lee, JP, Secretary for Security of the HKSAR Government, was invited as the Guest of Honour of the symposium. Responses to the symposium were overwhelming with the presence of more than 300 HKIE members.

**Information Technology Division:** The Division's highlight of the year was the Annual Conference and Dinner. Entitled "Digital Information Management, Security and Compliance", the conference aimed to provide a platform for the discussion and exchange of ideas on the development of data centres in Hong Kong. With focuses on building a sustainable information infrastructure, exploring innovative IT solutions and developing policies to facilitate information exchange between cities, the conference was highly relevant to engineers and professionals in cloud computing, data centres and information security. Very good responses were received.

**Manufacturing & Industrial Division:** The Division organised a two-day technical visit to the Pearl River Delta on the Mainland. The programme included visits to the Shenzhen Polytechnic, Shekou Container Terminals and two local manufacturing companies.

## May 2011

**Building Division, Electronics Division, Mechanical, Marine, Naval Architecture & Chemical Division and Associate Members Committee:** The four Divisions/Committee each successfully hosted their Annual Dinners in May.

**Fire Division:** The Division organised a technical visit to Singapore. The four-day visit, which covered Resorts World Sentosa, a mass transit underground station, Marina Bay Sands, Fullerton Hotel and Singapore Civil Defence Force, enhanced the participants' knowledge of fire safety designs for mega projects and heritage structures. Engineers from both cities also exchanged views and opinions on fire safety control in buildings and infrastructure projects.

**Geotechnical Division:** The Division's Annual Seminar was successfully held on 20 May with more than 300 participants attending. The theme of the seminar was "Landslide Risk Reduction through Works: 35 Years of Landslip Preventive Measures Programme and Beyond". It served as a forum to record, review and consolidate experiences in reducing landslide risks through research, design, work practices, management and education. More importantly, it offered a valuable opportunity for the attendants to look ahead and collaborate to overcome potential challenges facing the industry. Mrs Carrie Lam, JP, Secretary for Development of the HKSAR Government, was invited as the Guest of Honour of the seminar.

**Materials Division:** The Division organised a seminar on "Firestop Academy 2011 – A Gateway towards New Technology and Sustainability". This one-day seminar provided an update on the latest development in building design and technology with regard to enhancing fire safety and reducing the impacts on human health and the environment throughout a building's life cycle. The seminar was well attended by about 270 participants.

## June 2011

**Control, Automation & Instrumentation Division:** The Division's Annual Symposium on "Control, Automation and Instrumentation Systems for Sustainable Development" was well attended by about 150 participants. It provided a forum for engineers, academics, industrial managers, experts and related professionals to share their invaluable experiences and views.

**Geotechnical Division:** The Division jointly organised a seminar on "Geopark, Geoconservation and Sustainable Development 2011" with the Department of Geography & Resources Management of The Chinese University of Hong Kong and the Association for Geoconservation Hong Kong. Speakers from overseas, Mainland China and Hong Kong provided a broad and comprehensive view on the topic.

**Nuclear Division:** The Division and the Chartered Institution of Water and Environmental Management (Hong Kong Branch) jointly organised a technical seminar on "Nuclear Safety". Two overseas speakers were invited to present on issues relevant to nuclear safety, essential regulatory frameworks and risk perception of the general public on the nuclear industry.

**Structural Division:** The Division organised an Annual Seminar entitled "Meeting the Challenge of Low Carbon Emission" for professionals in different Disciplines in the construction industry. With an aim to promote low carbon emission in the built environment and to enhance understanding within the industry, the seminar focused on the application of innovative and integrative approaches to design, construct and revitalise our structures with due consideration to carbon dioxide emission and energy consumption. The seminar also highlighted the requirements for inter-disciplinary actions to sustain and optimise the natural, built and socio-economic environments. Prominent local and overseas speakers from the profession and academia shared their insights and experiences with those present at the seminar including practicing engineers, construction professionals and college students.

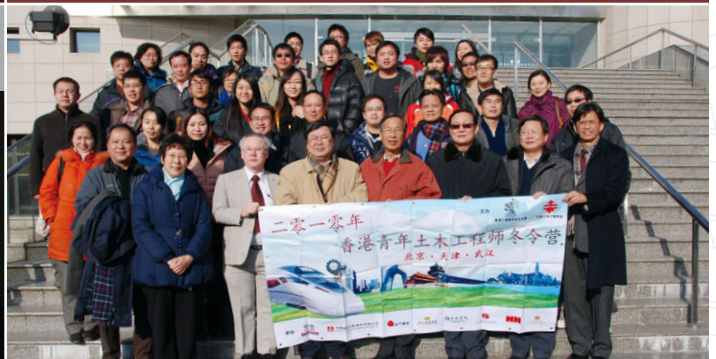

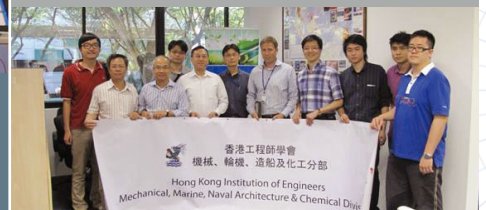

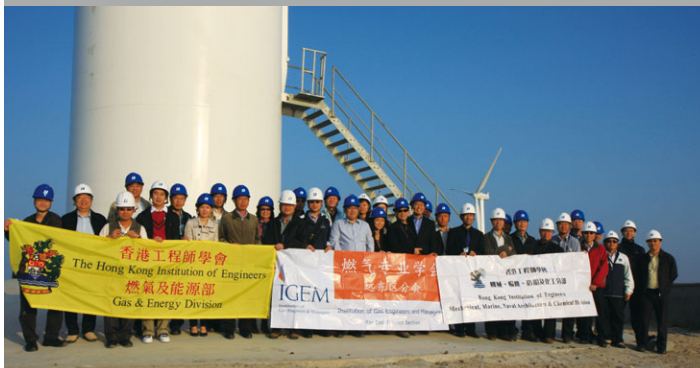

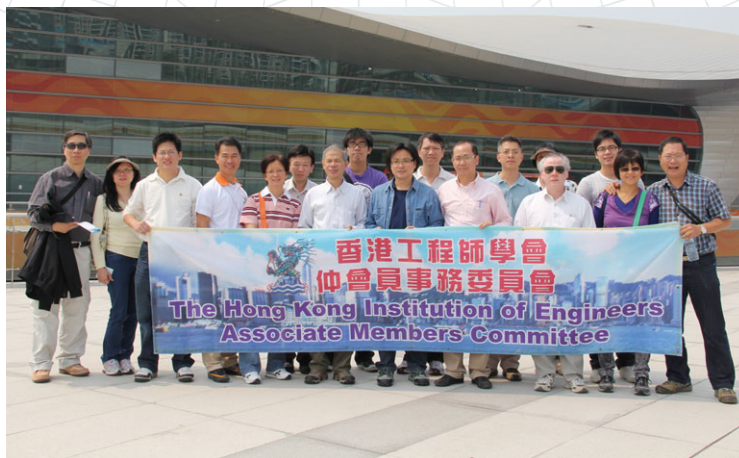
